
## **Tutorial: Course Viewing**

After you login you should click on the <u>My Courses</u> link in the main menu at the top of the pages. This screen will contain course titles for the course(s) with active (not expired) subscriptions.


Click on the <u>course title link</u> and it will show the course outline below. The course is devided into Modules and each module contains one or more Units (lessons). This grouping follows the course study guide and outline that you can download later.

You will see Unit titles shown in both black and blue type. Click on the <u>blue title</u> to view that lesson. Note that you must view the course units in sequential order.


The only units available for viewing will be units you have completed and the next unit in sequence. These are shown in blue. The titles in black are not yet accessible.



When you click on the first unit link, you will go to the first unit lesson page as seen here:




On the first unit only, you will be presented with a pop-up screen containing important information you should be aware of before you begin the course.




You can simply close the overlay by clcking the upper right corner or clicking anywhere on the surrounding page.

If you don't wish to see this page again when you vidit the first unit, click on the lower left corner link to "<u>Never see this message again</u>."



To begin the lesson, click on the video area. The video will begin in a few seconds.


When you <u>click on the video</u> it will pause. Click again and it will resume. Move you mouse over the video to reveal the control bar. This gives you information about the duration of the video and how far through the video you are currently. Before beginning each module, you must download the outline and study guide for the module by clicking the **Download link** on the right side of the page.



At the prompt, save the file to your computer and then print it.

Keep the printed version available as you watch the unit as you will need to fill in information from the screen. This document will become your proof of verifiable evidence of course completion as required by the Texas Department of Agriculture.

When you have completed the unit, you must click on the "<u>Mark as Completed</u>" button before you can move to the next Unit.



When you have indicated you are complete with this unit you will then see an acknowledgement (green circle with a check mark) and a blue button to click and move to the next unit.




